Commissioner Strafuss asked if professional services may be needed. The Commission decided to increase the professional service line from \$40,000 to \$90,000.

HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Commission discussed the Historical Society budget and decided to review it later in the day.

The commission reviewed and discussed other various budget items.

BUDGETED RAISES
