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TANEY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION DIVISION III STAFF REPORT RKC PROPERTIES JUNE 9, 2008 #08-37

Public Hearing for RKC Properties in the Branson Township Sec. 20 Twp. 23 Rng. 21.

The applicant, New Horizons Community Church requests approval to construct a gym, office, and warehouse.

History: Approved for Concept May 19, 2008.

<u>General Description</u>: The subject property contains 5.18 acres and is located at 1192 Bird Road. The adjoining properties to the request consist of commercial, multi-family, and multi-use.

<u>Review:</u> The proposed site will consist of a lot split with one lot as office warehouse buildings and the lot with the existing building will have the daycare. Taney County Public Water Supply District #3 will provide water and there will be an individual sewer system.

<u>Summary:</u> If the Taney County Planning Commission approves this request, the following requirements shall apply, unless revised by the Planning Commission:

- Compliance with the provisions of the Taney County Development Guidance Code that include plans for the following:
 - a. Sediment and erosion control (Appendix B Sec. VI Item 2)
 - b. Stormwater management (Appendix B Item 3)
 - c. Land grading permit (Appendix B)
 - Delineation of the 100 year floodplain (Taney County Floodplain Management Ordinance 60,3b Sec. A)
 - e. Utility easements and building line setbacks (Table 12)
 - Foliage screening or fencing for commercial area that adjoins residential tracts (Appendix C)
 - Improvements with scale of buildings, streets, onsite parking and utilities (Table 6)
- 2. Compliance letters from the Fire, Sewer and Water Districts (Chapter VI-VII).
- 3. No outside storage of equipment or solid waste materials.
- Division II Permits will be required for all applicable structures in the development (Chapter 3 Sec. 1 Item B)
- This decision is subject to all existing easements.
- 6. The Decision of Record shall be filed in the Taney County Recorder's Office within 120 days or the approval shall expire (Chapter II Item 6).
