- 4) Bids will be opened publicly at 9:00 AM on October 6, 2011 and read aloud. All bid responses will be considered public information and following contract execution or rejection of all bids, all responses will become a part of public record and will be released to any person or firm that requests it.
- 5) Bids may be withdrawn on written request from the Offeror at the address shown in the RFB prior to the time of acceptance of the Bid.
- 6) Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope identified with the bid number and date of closing. List the bid number on the outside of the box or envelope and note "Response to Request for Bid enclosed".
- 7) If you do not care to submit a bid, please return the *No Bid Response Page* and note your reason. No fax or electronic transmitted bids will be accepted.

- 1) This document constitutes a request for sealed bids for **Self-Propelled Power Broom** as set forth herein.

Guidelines for Written Questions:

- Questions regarding this Request for Bid shall be submitted in writing, prior to the bid opening and no later than 9:00 AM., on September 29, 2011. All questions must be mailed, faxed or emailed to; Ron Erickson, Director of Purchasing. Specific technical questions regarding the equipment must be directed to Road & Bridge Coordinator Randy Haes at 417-546-7924. All such questions will be answered in writing, and such answers will be provided to all parties having obtained a Request for Bid packet by the County by posting the addendum on the County Web site at www.taneycounty.org (select Current Bid Notices).
- In the event that it becomes necessary to revise any part of this RFB, written addenda will be issued. Any addendum to this RFB is valid only if in writing and issued by the Taney County Purchasing Department.

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REQUIREMENTS

The Taney County Road & Bridge District is in need of an additional **Self-Propelled Power Broom** for highway maintenance. As such the Taney County Purchasing Office will be accepting Bids, following all instructions within this package, who meet the following specifications. Any exceptions to the below specifications may be listed, with a detailed explanation, in the exception area of this document. Also, it is desired that Bidders offer an optional Bid with price details for a **Front Mounted** power broom as well as center mounted, both to include the same required specifications. (Again, the usual exception process must be followed for both.) Lastly, Taney County would also welcome any/all Bids involving **HIGH QUALITY "Pre-Owned" equipment** providing said is no older than 2010 and includes 90% of all listed specifications.
