TANEY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION DIVISION III STAFF REPORT SOUP SHOP MARCH 10, 2008 #08-4

Public Hearing for the Soup Shop in the Swan Township, Sec. 16 Twp. 23 Rng. 20.

The applicant, Stan Kolar requests approval to operate a small restaurant to be open for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

History: Approved for Concept February 19, 2008.

<u>General Description:</u> The subject property is located at 9383 East St. Hwy. 76. The adjoining properties to the request consist of residential and commercial.

<u>Review:</u> The proposed site consists of an existing single family dwelling, a large storage facility, and two other smaller buildings on 1.49 acres. The property is serviced by Public Water Supply District #2, and an individual septic system.

<u>Summary:</u> If the Taney County Planning Commission approves this request, the following requirements shall apply, unless revised by the Planning Commission:

- Compliance with the provisions of the Taney County Development Guidance Code that include plans for the following:
 - a. Sediment and erosion control (Appendix B Sec. VI Item 2)
 - b. Stormwater management (Appendix B Item 3)
 - Land grading permit (Appendix B)
 - Delineation of the 100 year floodplain (Taney County Floodplain Management Ordinance 60.3b Sec. A)
 - e. Utility easements and building line set backs (Table 12)
 - Foliage screening or fencing for commercial area that adjoins residential tracts (Appendix C)
 - g. Improvements with scale of buildings, streets, onsite parking and utilities (Table 6)
- 2. Compliance letters from the Fire, Sewer and Water Districts (Chapter VI-VII).
- 3. No outside storage of equipment or solid waste materials.
- Division II Permits will be required for all applicable structures in the development (Chapter 3 Sec. I Item B).
- The Decision of Record shall be filed with the Taney County Recorder's Office within 120 days or the approval shall expire (Chapter Ii Item 6).
