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TANEY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION DIVISION III STAFF REPORT INTEGRITY HILLS DEVELOPMENT NOVEMBER 10, 2008 #08-62

Public Hearing for Integrity Hills Development in the Oliver Township, Sec. 14 Twp. 21 Rng. 22.

The applicant, Quality Structures request approval to construct cabins, duplexes, and twelve plexes.

History: Approved for Concept October 20, 2008.

<u>General Description:</u> The subject property contains 81.87 acres and is located off St. Hwy. 86 to Tate Road. The adjoining properties to the request consist of residential and agricultural.

Review: The proposed site consists of a single family dwelling to be used for a clubhouse. The property will be serviced by a treatment plant and community well. The project received a score of -29. The negatives include; right of way/ roads, emergency water supply, slopes, use compatibility, pedestrian circulation, building bulk/scale, waste containers screening, development buffering, residential buffer/screening, residential privacy, traffic, usable open space, lot coverage, rooftop vents/equipment.

<u>Summary:</u> If the Taney County Planning Commission approves this request, the following requirements shall apply, unless revised by the Planning Commission:

- Compliance with the provisions of the Taney County Development Guidance Code that include plans for the following:
  - a. Sediment and erosion control (Appendix B Sec. VI Item 2)
  - b. Stormwater management (Appendix B Item 3)
  - c. Land grading permit (Appendix B)
  - Delineation of the 100 year floodplain (Taney County Floodplain Management Ordinance 60.3b Sec. A)
  - e. Utility easements and building line setbacks (Table 12)
  - f. Improvements with scale of buildings, streets, onsite parking an utilities (Table 6)
- 2. Compliance letters from the Fire, Sewer and Water Districts, Health Department, and MoDot.
- 3. No outside storage of equipment or solid waste materials.
- 4. This decision is subject to all existing easements.
- Division II Permits will be required for all applicable structures in the development (Chapter 3 Sec. I Item B).
- The Decision of Record shall be filed with the Taney County Recorder's Office within 120 days or the approval shall expire (Chapter II Item 6).
