Dear Ms. Lawrence:

Gilmore & Bell would like the opportunity to serve as Rebate Analyst to determine any arbitrage rebate liability for the above-referenced financing (the "Certificates"). The Certificates were issued on August 25, 2015 (the "Issue Date"), and federal tax laws require that an arbitrage calculation be completed and, if applicable, a payment to the Federal Government be made at least every five years and upon final redemption or maturity of the Certificates. If an arbitrage liability has been generated, it must be paid to the IRS within 60 days after the arbitrage calculation date or be subject to interest and penalties.

As Rebate Analyst, we will prepare an installment arbitrage calculation from the Issue Date to August 1, 2020. In addition to rendering our legal opinion along with this calculation, we will prepare a Form 8038-T for filing with the IRS if an arbitrage rebate payment is required.

Our fee for serving as Rebate Analyst will be 1,500, payable at the time the calculation is completed.
