INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN FIRE AGENCIES AND TANEY COUNTY

Pursuant to Section 70.220 RSMo., the Bradleyville Rural Fire Department, Branson Fire Department, Cedar Creek Fire Protection District, Central Taney County Fire Protection District, Forsyth Fire Department, Point Lookout Fire Department, Protem Fire Protection District, and Western Taney County Fire District (hereafter "Fire Agencies"), and the County of Taney, Missouri (hereafter "County") hereby enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement.

WHEREAS, Fire Agencies and County are political subdivisions, fire associations, and private fire departments located in the State of Missouri, and are authorized to enter into a joint agreement for common services; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Fire Agencies provide fire protection and other related emergency services to the people of Tancy County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, on extraordinary occasions, in responding to fires or related emergencies, Fire Agencies may need equipment which County owns and which is not otherwise available to the Fire Agencies; and

WHEREAS, County and the undersigned Fire Agencies desire to enter an agreement wherein the County, in its sole discretion and upon proper request by the Fire Agencies for assistance with equipment, may provide vehicles and equipment to assist Fire Agencies; and

WHEREAS, an agreement between County and Fire Agencies will provide for common services of good to the public and be of benefit to the citizens of County and members of the public served by Fire Agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION, of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- The WHEREAS clauses are incorporated herein.
- County, in its sole discretion, may assist Fire Agencies by providing County-owned vehicles or equipment for use in fighting fires or other related emergency situations.
- 3. In order to request assistance from County, the request shall be made by an authorized agent of the Fire Agency to the Office of the Taney County Emergency Management Executive Director, who may forward it for consideration by the Office of the Taney County Road and Bridge Administrator. The decision to provide County vehicles or equipment to assist Fire Agencies shall be made by the Road and Bridge Administrator, in his sole discretion.
- 4. In no event shall County provide vehicles or equipment if doing so would jeopardize the County employees or property.

NOW, THEREFORE, The County of Taney, Missouri and the County of Boone, Arkansas, each in consideration for the promises of the other made herein, agree:

- 1.) The "whereas" clauses of this document are incorporated by reference.
- 2.) The term of this Agreement shall be for four (4) years, commencing the date the agreement has been executed by all parties. The agreement shall renew automatically for an additional term of four (4) years unless either party gives written notice of nonrenewal before the agreement expires.
- 3.) This Agreement may be terminated by either party, without cause, by giving 30 days written notice to the other of termination.
- 4.) No modification of this Agreement shall be effective unless put in writing and executed by both parties.
- 5.) Taney County shall maintain that portion of Bald Eagle Point Road located in Boone County, AR.
