Under the direct supervision of the Animal Control Manager, the part-time Kennel Technician shall be responsible for providing proper care and safety of animals at the Taney County Animal Control. The part time kennel technician is required to work weekends and holidays. Open communication with supervisor and regular attendance are key requirements for this position.

## RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- > Feeds and waters animals following a routine schedule assuring for proper care and safety
- ➤ Washes and sanitizes food/water dishes
- Maintains clean work environment by cleaning kennels/bathing animals assuring for proper care/ safety
- ➤ Administers medications as scheduled assuring for proper care/safety
- > Receives phone calls and walk-ins
- ➤ Works with the public to locate animals that are missing or that are available for adoption
- Maintains an understanding of the costs/services associated with the kennel
- Receives payments and generates a receipt for payments
- > Transports animals and responds to calls in the field, as needed
