UNIFIRST CUSTOMER SERVICE AGREEMENT

The UniFirst Customer Service Agreement was tabled until 1 PM.

TOWER LEASE AGREEMENT

The County Commission discussed the Tower Lease Agreement, which was previously entered into on an annual basis, and was done with the goal of locating a repeater for the Sheriff's radio system. Bob Paulson, Legal Counsel amended it to a three year contract so that the Commission does not have to come back annually.

Commissioner Strafuss moved to approve the Tower Lease Agreement with corrections that Legal Counsel has mentioned and authorize Ron Houseman to sign. Commissioner Strahan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Houseman (absent), Strahan (aye), and Strafuss (aye).

TOWER LEASE AGREEMENT

This Agreement, entered into on this ____ day of March, 2011, by, and between Word of God Fellowship, Inc., d/b/a Daystar Television Network, hereinafter called Owner, whose address is 3901 Highway 121, Bedford, Texas 76021-3009 and the Taney County Commission for Taney County, Missouri, whose address is P.O. Box 1086, Forsyth, MO 65653, hereinafter called Renter, witnesseth that:

- 1. The Owner lets and the Renter rents space for its radio transmission repeater to be located on Owner's tower located at 468 Church Camp Road, Taneyville, Missouri.
- 2. The Renter shall pay to Owner the sum of \$500.00 annually for the use of the tower with payments of \$125.00, due quarterly on the first day of March, June, September and December beginning on the 1st day of March, 2011, for the space for Renter's transmission repeater on Owner's Tower. The March 2011 payment shall be due upon execution of this agreement.
- 3. The Renter agrees, as part of the consideration of this Lease, to hold and save harmless Owner and it successors and assigns, from and against any and all loss, damage, injury or death claims, demands and liability of every nature, arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with the transmission repeater and its location on Owner's tower. Renter agrees to indemnify Owner from all injury and damage arising out of the presence of Renter's repeater on Owner's tower except in any case arising from the negligence of Owner. Renter agrees to maintain an insurance policy in the amount of at least \$1,000,000.00 (One Million Dollars) covering any damages arising out of the placement of Renter's repeater on Owner's tower and said insurance policy shall name Owner as additional insured.
- 4. The term of this Contract is for 2011, 2012 and 2013 and shall expire at midnight December 31, 2013. Renter has the option to renew on an annual basis by giving written notice to the Owner at its address listed here, 3901 Highway 121, Bedford, Texas 76021-3009, in at least 30 days prior to the end of the current three-year term.

UNIFIRST CUSTOMER SERVICE AGREEMENT

Commissioner Strafuss moved to approve the UniFirst Customer Service Agreement as presented by Counsel. Commissioner Strahan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Houseman (absent), Strafuss (aye) and Strahan (aye).

AGREEMENT FOR SUPPLY OF MATS AND RELATED SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

Taney County, Missouri (hereinafter "County" or "Customer") enters into this agreement with UniFirst Corporation and/or UniFirst Holdings, L.P. dba UniFirst and/or UniFirst Canada LTD. (hereinafter "UniFirst") for the supply of mats, and related supplies and services as more fully set forth on the attached Order Form entitled "Customer Service Agreement". The terms of this agreement are as set forth in this Agreement and in the attached order form, including the terms on the reverse side of that order form. In the event of any contradiction between this Agreement and the attached order form with the terms on the reverse side, the terms of this agreement shall prevail.

Merchandise ordered and to be supplied.

The merchandise ordered that is to be supplied and serviced is as set forth in the attached Customer Service Agreement/Order Form.

Price.

The price for all merchandise and services is as set forth in the Customer Service Agreement/Order Form.

Term of agreement and termination provision.

The term of this agreement is for two (2) years beginning on the date this agreement is signed by all parties, however, customer may terminate the agreement at any time without any penalty or liquidated damages provided customer gives at least thirty (30) days prior written notice to UniFirst or its sales representative Brandon Hardison.

Choice of law and venue.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri, and venue shall be proper only in the Circuit Court of Taney County, Missouri.

Attorney's fees and court costs.

In the event of litigation between the parties to this agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to its reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.

Conflict between this Agreement and the attached "Customer Service Agreement" order form.

In the event of any conflict and/or contradiction between the terms set forth in this agreement and the terms set forth on the attached "Customer Service Agreement" order form and the language on the reverse side of said document, then the provisions set forth

in this agreement shall take precedence and prevail over any conflicting or contradicting term contained in the attachment.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Commissioner Strafuss briefed the public on document retention, stating that the County Commission was going through old documents, some of which were Commissioner Pennel's. He stated that the County applied and qualified for a Missouri at Work Program which facilitated the hiring of an employee for six weeks for 24 hours per week, free of charge.

Commissioner Strafuss discussed the upcoming Sunshine Week. He made contact with Tom Durkin, Attorney General's Office, Jefferson City, MO who gave three dates: one at the end of March and two in April, to do an open session on the sunshine law. There will be two seminars, one morning session at the Court House and one evening session at the Taney County Airport in the terminal area.

Commissioner Strahan discussed the MAC Recording session, and the 20 hours of DVD Training the County Commission has to watch to become certified and receive their certificates.

James Strahan, Assessor, reminded the public to turn in their personal property forms, as the deadline is March, 1, 2011. He requested that any taxpayers who had lost the personal property form call the County Assessor's Office at 546-7240, to avoid substantial penalties from late filings.

Don Ehrhardt stated his concerns about the State of Missouri being known as the Meth Capital. He expressed that the law was prohibiting the Sheriff's department from doing a better job. He would like everyone to support their local Sheriff's department and deputies and get meth out of Taney County.
