Debris Removal

Debris can be taken to:

Burnable vegetative debris and untreated lumber:
Shoals Bend Park at East Hwy 76 and Birmingham Road. Monday-Sunday from 8:00am-5:00pm through March 11, 2012

Non-burnable storm debris:
Taney County Transfer Station on Buchanan Road. Hours are Monday-Sunday from 8:00am-5:00pm through March 11, 2012. There will be no charge and vegetative debris WILL NOT be accepted.

COMMERCIAL HAULERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT EITHER LOCATION

Shelter is Closed and the Multi-Agency Resource Center is Opening

The Shelter at the Branson RecPlex closed Sunday at noon. If you have sheltering needs a number is listed below.

The American Red Cross will be opening a Multi-Agency Resource Center (MARC) in Branson at 12:00 p.m. Monday, March 5 at The Red Roof Mall Building #7, 1000 Pat Nash Drive. If you use the Gretna Road entrance it will take you directly to Building #7. Hours on Monday will be 12:00pm-5:00pm and Tuesday-Saturday 8:00am-5:00pm.

The MARC will be a place where people affected by the disaster can connect with social services nonprofits, faith-based organizations and local, state and federal agencies. Individuals will be informed of various services available to them.

Red Cross Damage Assessment teams will also be going out into the affected areas.
