GRANT OF PERMANENT AND PERPETUAL EASEMENT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR PUBLIC ROAD PURPOSES AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC ROAD IMPROVEMENTS Meadow Ridge Property Owners Association, Inc., a Missouri Non-Profit Corporation, of the County of Taney in the State of Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "GRANTORS", on this 13th day of <u>Thosech</u>, 2018 grant and demands of all persons whomsoever. Box 1086, Forsyth, Missouri 65653 a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referre to as "GRANTEE", for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration received, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for the advantages to be gained from the existence of such road improvements, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer, and confirm unto GRANTEE, its successors, heirs and assigns, a permanent and transter, and commit unto OKAN tize, its successors, nets and assigns, a permanent and perpetual easement and right-of-way, for the purpose of water drainage on the public road now known as Mesquite Road (248-20H-1). Meadow Ridge Property Owners Association, Inc let Legally described as set forth in Exhibit "Exhibit "A" and "B" to this easement document, and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set out

Together with the right of ingress to and egress from the adjacent lands of GRANTORS, their successors and assigns, for the purposes of this easement, to-wit:

To have and to hold the premises aforesaid for the aforesaid use with all and singular the rights, privileges, appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, unto the GRANTEE, its representatives and assigns forever; the said GRANTORS hereby covenanting that GRANTORS are lawfully seized of an indefeasible estate in fee in the premises herein conveyed; that GRANTORS have good right to grant and convey the same; that the said premises are free and clear of any encumbrances done or suffered by GRANTORS or those under whom GRANTORS claim and that Grantors will warrant and defend the title to the said premises unto the said GRANTEE and unto its successors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and

# ANIMAL CONTROL JURISDICTIONAL AGREEMENT - CITY OF ROCKAWAY **BEACH #18-002AC**

Commissioner Williams moved to approve the agreement by and between Taney County and Rockaway Beach for the Animal Control Jurisdictional Agreement. Commissioner Wyatt seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Scofield (aye), Williams (aye), and Wyatt (aye).

# AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this K day of May 21. ("Effective Date"), by and between Taney County, Missouri ("County"), a county of the first classification, and the City of Relation Accel City"), a city of the \_\_\_\_\_ classification.

WITNESS:

WHEREAS, the County owns and operates an animal control facility ("Facility") for the purpose of providing care for lost, stray, vicious, sick and injured animals and ("Animals"); and

WHEREAS, the County and City desire to enter into this Agreement to enable the City to utilize the Facility and the resources of the County for the temporary shelter and care of Animals; and

WHEREAS, the County and City desire to set forth the respective duties and responsibilities of the parties; and

WHEREAS, section 70.220, RSMo. permits political subdivisions to contract and cooperate with one another for the planning, development, construction, acquisition or operation of any public improvement or facility or common service; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth the parties agree as follows:

1. Term. The term of this Agreement shall be from the Effective Date to December 31, 2018, and shall automatically renew for additional one (1) year terms unless terminated by ither of the parties.

2. <u>Covered Services</u>

a. <u>Care of Animals</u>. In consideration of the Intake Fee set forth in Schedule A, the County shall provide appropriate food, water, boarding, cleaning supplies and labor necessary in order to care for each Animal accepted by the Facility for the period of time set forth in Schedule A. The additional holding fee shall apply for any Animal housed longer than the holding period, as provided in Schedule A, at the option of the City. In the event the owner of an Animal is not located and the Animal is not claimed and redeemed, the County agrees to attempt to place each Animal for adoption or to provide a humane euhanasia.

b. <u>Specified Vaccination of Animels.</u> Upon transportation and acceptance of an Animal by the Facility, the County shall vaccinate: (1) a canize Animal for parvo and upper respiratory/kennel cough; or (2) a feline Animal for leukemia and upper respiratory/kennel cough, pursuant to the Facility's Missouri Department of Agriculture License.

City shall be responsible for costs incurred in order to stabilize the wellness of the Animal.

c. <u>Stray Hold.</u> The Facility will hold stray animals at the request of the City, and the City shall be responsible for the fees incurred.

Fees. In consideration for the Services described in paragraph 2, the City shall pay inty the fees (each a "Fee") set forth in Schedule A, which is attached hereto and incorporated

5. <u>Invoices and Billing: Payment</u>. The City shall complete an impound form requiring formation as is required by the County for each Animal presented to the Facility for nee. The County shall maintain a ledger of the date, time, species, and description of each delivered to and accepted by the Facility. The County shall benefit an invoice to the City onthly basis containing a description of the services provided by the County to the City his Agreement. The City shall pay each invoice within 30 days of the date of the invoice. eceptance. Animal deli in a month this A

<u>Termination</u>. This Agreement may be terminated by the County or City upon for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:

- a. Upon thirty (30) days advance written notice by either party;
- b. Due to a material breach of any term or condition of this agreement; or
- e. If appropriations are not made available and budgeted for any calendar year.

7. <u>Assignment.</u> This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without written consent by the other party.

8. <u>Notices.</u> All notices, demands and requests to be given hereunder by either party shall be in writing and must be sent by certified mail and shall be deemed properly given if tendered at the address set forth below or at such other address as either party shall designate by written notice to the other:

9. <u>Binding Effect</u>. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

All Animals over the age of four (4) months that are transferred out of the Facility shall be vaccinated for rabies, or in the event the Animal's redeemed by the owner, the owner shall provide proof of the Animal's rabies vaccination. If the Animal is redeemed by the owner, and the owner is unable to provide proof of the Animal's rabies vaccination, the County shall charge the owner for the rabies vaccination (a "Fee"), pursuant to the schedule of fees attached hereio and incorporated herein by reference as Schedule A. If the Animal is not claimed and redeemed by the owner, the City shall be responsible for payment of the Fee to the County.

- c. <u>Redemption</u>. The County shall charge the Redemption Fee set forth in Schedule A for an owner of an Animal to claim and redeem the Animal from the custody of the Facility.
- d. <u>Transfer to Rescue</u>. Upon the request of the City, the County shall transfer an Animal to rescue for the cost of the Rabies Vaccination set forth in Schedule A plus the actual cost of fuel and time to transport the Animal to a rescue facility, to be paid by the City.
- e. <u>Adoption</u>. In the event the owner of an Animal is not located and the Animal is not claimed by the owner and redeemed, the County may adopt an Animal in the custody of the Facility in accordance with the County's policy on adoptions. The Adoption Fee set forth in Schedule A covers the cost of veterinary services, including rabies vaccination and microchipping, which shall be paid by the person adopting the Animal, to the County.
- Non-Covered Services. 3.
  - a. <u>Animal Pickup: Transportation</u>. The City shall be responsible for transporting Animals to the Facility with its personnel and at its own expense. The City shall be responsible for the custody, care and control of Animals picked up or delivered to the City outside of the Facility's regular business hours at the City's own facility. The City shall not be permitted to deliver Animals to the Facility outside the Facility's regular business hours.
  - b. <u>Sick and Injured Animals; Veterinarian Expenses.</u> The Facility will not accept any sick or injured Animals, subject to the sole and absolute discretion of the County. Sick and injured Animals should be transported to the City's designated veterinarian. The City shall be responsible for contracting with a veterinarian in order to provide necessary and appropriate veterinary care for any Animal in its custody, and the City shall be responsible for any and all costs associated with veterinarian care provided to Animals in the City's custody or control. If after the intake of the animal, the Facility has reason to believe an Animal is sick, in the discretion of the Facility, and is in need of veterinary care,

10. Amendments. This Agreement may not be amended, altered, or modified except by an instrument in writing duly executed by the parties hereto.

11. Severability. If any provision of this Agreement or any application thereof is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions or any application thereof shall not be affected or impaired.

12. Section Headines. Section headings are for convenience only and shall have no legal effect or significance.

13. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specifications or contractual agreement.

14. <u>Governine Law: Venue</u>. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Missouri. Venue for any dispute arising out of the formation, interpretation, or claims regarding a breach of this Agreement shall be solely and exclusively in the Circuit Court of Taney County, Missouri.

Authority. The parties represent and warrant that all actions necessary in order to create a legal, valid, and binding agreement between the parties have been taken prior to execution of this Agreement.
