THIS ADDENDUM, entered into on the date set forth below, by and between County of Taney, Missouri ("County") and HDR Engineering, Inc. ("Engineer").

WHEREAS, County and Engineer entered into a Master Short Form Agreement for Professional Services, dated January 2, 2018, for engineering, consulting and related services ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, desire to amend the Contract pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and obligations set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

Owner and Engineer have evaluated the risks and rewards associated with this project, including Engineer's fee relative to the risks assumed, and agree to allocate certain of the risks, so, to the fullest extent permitted by law, the total aggregate liability of engineer (and its related corporations, subconsultants and employees) to Owner and third parties granted reliance is limited to \$1,000,000 for any and all injuries, damages, claims, losses, or expenses (including attorney and expert fees) arising out of engineer's services or this Agreement regardless of cause(s) or the theory of liability, including negligence, indemnity, or other recovery."
- 3. This Addendum is subject to the Contract and to each and every term, covenant, condition and agreement set forth therein, except to the extent provided in paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Addendum. County and Engineer agree to continue to be bound by the remaining terms of the Contract for the additional term of the Contract.

INTER-GOVERNMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN TANEY COUNTY, MISSOURI AND THE CITY OF ROCKAWAY BEACH

ROCKAWAY BEACH REGIONAL WWTF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (CONSTRUCTION PHASE)

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into between Taney County, Missouri (hereinafter referred to as "County) and the City of Rockaway Beach (hereinafter referred to as "City").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 70.220 RSMo, the County and City authorized to enter into agreements for the planning, development, construction, acquisition or operation of any public improvement or facility, or for a common service; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above stated authority the County may enter into agreements for the purpose of making improvements to sewer systems within Taney County through projects utilizing expenditures of Sewer Sales Tax Funds (hereinafter "Sewer Sales Tax"); and

WHEREAS, the County shall oversee sewer sales tax funds which may be made available for use in areas of Taney County to finance capital improvements to their waste water infrastructure. It has been determined that the project (Rockaway Beach Regional WWTF Capital Improvements Project — Construction Phase) is feasible and meets the criteria necessary under the Sewer Sales Tax Guidelines. This project will provide for the following improvements to be made to the Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF):

- 1. Influent Headworks Improvements
- Ultraviolet Disinfection System Improvements
 Sludge Processing Improvements
- 4. Return Activated Sludge Pumping Improvements
- 5. Selector Basin Improvements
- 6. Aeration System Improvements
- 7. Tertiary Backwash Filter Equalization Improvements
- 8. Emergency Backup Power Generator Addition
- 9. Construction Phase Engineering Services Necessary to Oversee Project

TOPIC F - EMPLOYEE BENEFITS: (SECTIONS 17, 18)

SECTION 17. GROUP AND VOLUNTARY BENEFITS

Section 17-1. Group and Voluntary Benefits.

All regular full-time employees are eligible for group health benefits. Full-time employees, as defined under the Affordable Care Act, are employees who work an average of thirty (30) hours per week for more than one hundred-twenty (120) days in one (1) year.

Full-time employees will be enrolled, without cost, in the group health, dental and basic group life insurance programs. All coverage, which includes any voluntary and dependent coverage paid in full by employee, will begin on the first day of the calendar month following sixty (60) days from the date of hire.
