LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (Event Sponsor)

In consideration of being permitted to offer, conduct, organize or sponsor Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activities or events, on real property owned by Taney County, Missouri ("County") located 132 David Street, Forsyth, Missouri, or 266 Main Street, Forsyth, Missouri, which are conducted, organized or sponsored by Forsyth Chamber of Commerce, and its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, or agents, and being permitted to enter onto or participate for any purpose upon the property for which Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activities or events are offered, conducted, organized or sponsored by Forsyth Chamber of Commerce ("Chamber"), Chamber agrees as follows:

1. Chamber acknowledges, agrees, and represents that it has or will immediately upon entering the Premises and continuously thereafter, inspect the Premises, and further agrees and warrants that if at any time Chamber and its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents or participants are in or about the Premises and feel or observe anything to be unsafe, Chamber will immediately advise County of such and if necessary, will immediately require all officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents, participants, observers, attendees, and all others to immediately leave the Premises.

2. Chamber and its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents and participants release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the County, or its officers, officials, employees, volunteers, or agents (collectively, the "Released Parties"), as an owner or lessor of the Premises at which any Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activity or event is held, from all liability to Chamber, and its personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, for any and all loss or damages, and any claim or demands on account of injury to person or property or resulting in death or injury to the Chamber arising out of or related to the Premises, and any and all Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activities or events, whether caused by the negligence of the County, or not.

3. Chamber agrees to indemnify and save and hold harmless the County, and its officers, officials, employees, volunteers, or agents from any loss, liability, damage or cost that may be incurred arising out of or related to the Premises, and any Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activities or events, whether caused by the County, or not.

4. Chamber assumes full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death or property damage, including, but not limited to any person(s) on the Premises, arising out of or related to the Premises, and any Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activities, events, or clinics, whether caused by the negligence of the County, or not.

5. Chamber agrees that this Liability Waiver and Release, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the County, and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Missouri, and that if any portion is held invalid, it is agreed that the remaining part of the Agreement shall continue in full legal force and effect.

6. Chamber agrees to be responsible for the safety of its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents and participants in any Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show activities or events. Chamber agrees that if at any point prior to, during, or after Harvest Moon Festival and Car Show

2019 TANEY COUNTY, MISSOURI & TDD INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("<u>Agreement</u>") is made, entered and effective as of September 16, 2019, by and between the COUNTY OF TANEY, MISSOURI ("<u>COUNTY</u>"), and the BRANSON, MISSOURI REGIONAL AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ("<u>TDD</u>") and BRANSON AIRPORT, LLC ("<u>BA</u>").

WHEREAS, the TDD was lawfully created on or about September 4, 2003, pursuant to § 238.200 through 238.275, inclusive, as amended, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri (the "<u>TDD</u> <u>Act</u>") for the purpose of, among other things, developing the Branson, Missouri Regional Airport (the "<u>Airport</u>") located in Taney County, Missouri, and the TDD has entered into an Airport Lease, whereby the TDD leases certain property owned by the COUNTY (the "<u>Airport Lease</u>"), and a separate Operating Lease (the "<u>Operating Lease</u>") with Branson Airport, LLC ("<u>BA</u>") with respect to the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the TDD are public governmental bodies that are authorized to cooperate and enter into agreements with respect to matters relating to the airports; and

WHEREAS, the Airport provides a substantial public benefit to the COUNTY, the TDD and the citizens of the COUNTY by creating tourism, transportation infrastructure and the resulting revenue benefits derived therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the purposes of the TDD will be furthered by the TDD's performance of its activities hereunder; and

WHEREAS, as new airlines agree to serve the Airport and open new routes to and from the Airport, the public benefit to the COUNTY and the TDD increases; and

WHEREAS, because of the COUNTY's ownership of the land underlying the Airport, its interest under the Airport Lease, and the substantial public benefit derived from the Airport, the COUNTY has a substantial interest in its continued operation and viability; and

WHEREAS, in order to support the continued viability of the Airport and aid the TDD in attracting additional commercial air carriers or new air carrier routes ("<u>New Airline</u>") to the Airport, the parties desire to enter into this Agreement whereby the COUNTY will pledge the possible use of funds (the "<u>Risk Mitigation Guarantee</u>") in order to off-set financial risk incurred by any New Airline who may as a result of this Agreement agree to provide service to the Airport, thereby providing additional transportation alternatives all to the economic benefit of the COUNTY and its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, effective April 1, 2015, the TDD and the COUNTY entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (the "<u>Original Agreement</u>"), the First Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement dated February 22, 2016 (the "<u>First Amendment</u>"), the Second Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement dated April 27, 2016 (the "<u>Second Amendment</u>"), and the Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement dated April 2, 2018 (the "<u>Amended</u>
