INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY THE COUNTY AND WITH THE CITY OF FORSYTH FOR 911 DISPATCH SERVICES 2020 (19-139CM)

Commissioner Wyatt moved to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement by Taney County and the City of Forsyth for 911 Dispatch Services. Temporary Presiding Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Scofield (absent), Williams (aye) and Wyatt (aye).

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY THE COUNTY OF TANEY AND THE CITY OF FORSYTH FOR 911 DISPATCH SERVICES

Whereas, the City of Forsyth (hereafter 'City') is a municipality and the County of Taney (hereafter 'County') is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri and are authorized to enter into an agreement to provide common police and fire services pursuant to Missouri Constitution, Article 6, RSMo 70.220 and RSMo 70.815; and

Whereas, City and County each, for and in consideration of the promises herein made by the other, hereby agree:

- 1. The term of this agreement shall be for 12 months from the date it is fully executed.
- 2. No modifications of the terms of this agreement shall be valid until placed in writing and authorized by a majority of the governing body of each of the parties hereto.
- 3. The 'whereas' paragraphs above are incorporated herein.
- 4. The City shall hire, and at all times be the sole employer of, a 911 Communications Officer (hereafter Communications Officer).
- The City shall maintain liability and workers compensation insurance covering the Communications Officer, as required by law.
- The City shall select the Communications Officer pursuant to its normal procedures. The City shall not employ the Communications Officer until the Sheriff of County approves the individual selected.
- The City shall pay all costs and expenses incurred to train and qualify the Communications Officer, unless this agreement to do so has been modified by prior agreement of the parties.
- 8. The pay and benefits to be provided the Communications Officer shall be set by the City and all pay and benefits shall be the sole responsibility of the City.
- 9. The work schedule for the Communications Officer shall be set by the Sheriff of County in his sole discretion. Time off from work, as authorized by the Communication Officer's employment agreement with the City, shall be scheduled by the Sheriff of County in his sole discretion.
- 10. The Communications Officer shall be required to follow all policies and procedures of the City and the Sheriff of County, and in the event conflicts arise, these will be resolved by the Mayor of the City, or his designee, and the Sheriff of County, with the results to be put in writing and signed by both.
- 11. City agrees that the individual employed as Communications Officer described in this Agreement must be and remain reasonably acceptable to Sheriff of County. The Communications Officer shall be subject to the direction of Sheriff, as well as policies and procedures of the City and Sheriff, as more fully described in paragraph 10. Sheriff

AGREEMENT FOR HVAC UNIT (#19-135RB)

HVAC UNIT (Road & Bridge Carpenter's Shop)

THIS AGREEMENT dated the _____ day of _____ 201_is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and Snowden's Heating & Air Conditioning, LLC. hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement shall include the Proposal attached to this Agreement. Product or Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.
- 2. Contract Price. County agrees to purchase, and Contractor agrees to sell labor, materials, and equipment for a 3-ton Heat Pump (AC & Heater Unit) with accessories and services as described in the Contract Documents for the Taney County Road & Bridge Department Carpenter's Shop in Hilda, Missouri for the price not to exceed \$4200.00. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Equipment availability, the County may consider all other options.
- 3. Contract Duration. This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties as listed within the attached Contract Documents. This agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing, and delivery clauses as agreed to, and offered by the Proposal.
- 4. Billing and Payment. All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

- <u>2. Contract Price.</u> County agrees to purchase and Contractor agrees to sell to County a generator, and the contract price shall not exceed \$5000.00. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Equipment availability, the County may consider all other options.
- 3. Contract Duration. This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable, or available, warranties. This agreement may only be extended by the order of the County Commission subject to the pricing, and delivery clauses as agreed to, and offered by the Contractor.
- 4. Billing and Payment. All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

FILL DIRT AGREEMENT

COMES NOW the Taney County Commission on behalf of Taney County; .Missouri, (hereinafter "Taney County") and enters into this agreement with (hereinafter Owner), regarding the dumping of dirt fill on Owner's property, and the particulars of the agreement are as follows:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Taney County, Missouri's Road and Bridge Department would benefit from a location near ongoing construction to dump excess and unneeded fill dirt; and,

WHEREAS, having said location would save Taney County's Road and Bridge Department a considerable amount in hauling costs; and

WHEREAS, Owner will benefit from having needed fill dirt dumped on Owner's property;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS AGREED AND COVENANTED BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

General Provisions.

Taney County, as the need arises, is granted permission by Owner to dump fill dirt upon locations on Owner's property that Owner has previously designated to receive such material.

Term and Notice.

The term of this agreement shall commence upon the first date upon which all parties have signed this agreement and shall continue until terminated by one party or the other.

Hold Harmless

Owner agrees that it will hold Taney County, its employees, representatives, heirs and assigns harmless from any claims arising from or relating to this agreement except for any gross negligence.
