## AGREEMENT for MOTOR REPLACEMENT (Coop.)

THIS AGREEMENT dated the day of day of December 201 is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, herein "County" and The Larson Group, Inc. (DBA/ Peterbilt of Springfield) of Strafford, Missouri 65757 herein "Contractor".

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement shall include NJPA Contract #: 081716-PMC, including the Contract Acceptance and Award, and Invoice No. Q127784, dated December 4, 2019, which are attached to this Agreement. Product or Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.
- 2. Contract Price. Contractors agrees to sell and County agrees to purchase the products and services described in the Contract Documents for a motor replacement for Road and Bridge ("Product & Services"), including labor, and unexpected discoveries during replacement, with a contract price which shall not exceed; \$38,000.00. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Product availability, the County may consider all other options. All charges, costs, and services performed are sanctioned by RSMo.70.220 for cooperative purchasing.
- 3. Contract Duration. This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all available warranties.
- 4. Billing and Payment. All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.
- <u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.
- <u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.

# AMENDMENT TO INTER-GOVERNMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN TANEY COUNTY, MISSOURI AND THE CITY OF ROCKAWAY BEACH

## ROCKAWAY BEACH REGIONAL WWTF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (CONSTRUCTION PHASE)

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into between Taney County, Missouri (hereinafter referred to as "County") and the City of Rockaway Beach (hereinafter referred to as "City").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and City entered into an Inter-Governmental Funding Agreement on November 26, 2018 for the purpose of completing the improvements outlined in the Rockaway Beach Regional WWTF Capital Improvements Project (Construction Phase) Funding Agreement by March 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, due to the City's desire to add additional improvements to the project as outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, the City is requesting a new agreement termination date of June 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, the original funding agreement amount approved by the Commission was \$1,885,685.00. Due to the additional improvements to the project, the City is requesting that the original funding agreement amount be increase by \$121,813.40 resulting in a revised funding agreement amount of \$2,007,498.40.

WHEREAS, the County agrees to extend the agreement termination date for the completion of the project to June 30, 2020 and increase the funding agreement amount to \$2,007,498.40.

WHEREAS, THE PARTIES AGREE that all other aspects of the agreement(s) for this project remain in effect.
