AGREEMENT FOR GEAR BAGS (182) #20-087CM

Commissioner Williams moved to approve the agreement for Gear Bags by and between Taney County and Fire Master Fire Equipment. Commissioner Wyatt seconded the motion with discussion. The motion passed by vote: Scofield (aye), Williams (aye), and Wyatt (aye).

AGREEMENT for Gear Bags (182)

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 24 day of August 2020s made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and Fire Master Fire Equipment, Inc. of Springfield, Missouri (hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

<u>1. Contract Documents.</u> The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of one hundred eighty-two (182) Gear Bags ("Equipment") shall include the Contractor's quote and any applicable addenda which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

<u>2. Contract Price.</u> Equipment provided under this Agreement shall not exceed the costs as quoted in Contractor's quote. The County agrees to this purchase and Contractor agrees to supply the County the items, services, and construction per the Contractor's quote, and for the prices set forth in the Contractor's quote, and as ordered by County. If any issues arise which may hinder or delay Equipment availability or delivery, County may consider all options.

<u>3. Contract Duration.</u> This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties, details of which are attached to the signed bid, also as subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may only be extended by the order of the county subject to the pricing, and delivery clauses as agreed to, and offered by the contractor's quote.

<u>4. Billing and Payment.</u> All billing shall be invoiced with specific department information and include quote date of 6-5-2020 for tracking. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for in this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

<u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

<u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.

MUTUAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM #20-088CM

WHEREAS, County and City entered into a Mutual Cooperation Agreement for 911 Emergency Telephone System, dated August 28, 2020, attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>, for the parties to establish and maintain two Public Service Answering Points in order to provide a 911 Emergency Telephone System and Public Service Answering Points in Taney County, Missouri ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, desire to amend the Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and obligations set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. <u>Renewal.</u> The parties agree to revise paragraph 4 of the Agreement, and to renew the Agreement for an additional term of one (1) year, effective August 28, 2020, and ending August 27, 2021. The Agreement shall automatically renew for one (1) additional one (1) year term unless any party provides advance written notice at least thirty (30) days prior to the renewal date. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth herein, any party may terminate the Agreement, in its sole and absolute discretion, by providing 60-days advance written notice.

2. <u>Original Agreement</u>. This Addendum is subject to the Agreement and to each and every term, covenant, condition and agreement set forth therein, except to the extent provided in paragraph 1 of this Addendum. County and City agree to continue to be bound by the remaining terms of the Contract.
