LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this day of tebruory, 2021, by and between the Taney County Commission on behalf of **Taney County**, Missouri (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" or "LESSOR") and Bob's Rentals, Inc. dba AVIS, a Missouri corporation (hereinafter referred to as "LESSEE").

WHEREAS, Taney County, Missouri, is the owner of the Taney County Airport/M. Graham Clark Field (hereinafter referred to as "Airport"), located at Point Lookout in Taney County, Missouri, and

WHEREAS, County has space available for the operation of automobile rental businesses in said terminal building at the Airport, and

WHEREAS, LESSEE is desirous of securing and entering into a concession agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") to provide adequate facilities and service to meet the demands of the public, patrons, and other persons at the Airport for services of the type and character herein required by County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained to be kept and performed and the consideration to be paid to County by Lessee, do agree as follows:

I. LEASED PREMISES, TERM, RENTAL

That in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained on the part of the LESSEE to be observed and performed, the COUNTY does hereby lease and demise unto the LESSEE and the LESSEE does hereby take, lease and hire from the COUNTY the premises which consists of certain space at the M. Graham Clark Field-Taney County Airport, located at Point Lookout, Taney County, Missouri, said premises more particularly described as follows:

(A) Terminal Building: Counter area as assigned by Airport Manager (the "Leased Premises").

To have and to hold unto the LESSEE, its successors and assigns, for the term of one (1) year commencing the 1^{st} day of January, 2021, and ending on the 31^{th} day of <u>December</u>, 2021. At the expiration of the term of this Agreement, the agreement may be extended or a new agreement entered into after negotiation, upon the approval, in writing, of both parties.

TANEY COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE - 2021-MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT & PROFESSSIONAL PLANNING SERVICES #21-005CM Presiding Commissioner Scofield referenced a letter from their attorney.

Commissioner Wyatt moved to approve the Taney County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update 2021 between Southwest Missouri Council of Governments (SMCOG) and Taney County. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Scofield (aye), Williams (aye), and Wyatt (aye).

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is entered by and between The County Commission of Taney County and the Southwest Missouri Council of Governments (SMCOG), and is effective as of this 3 day of ______, 2020 1

WHEREAS, the SMCOG has received funding from the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA), a recipient of federal grant funding, to finance the preparation of a Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan, predicated upon this agreement by Taney County to provide the nonfederal grant match of at least twentyfive-percent of the total price of the planning project;

WHEREAS, The County agrees to provide the non-federal cash match in the amount of \$7,333.33, or a payment-in-kind (non-cash) match valued at a maximum of fifty-percent the same amount necessary to qualify for the SEMA Agreement;

WHEREAS, Taney County is a paid member of the SMCOG and is eligible for a fifty-percent in-kind match, in the amount of \$3,666.67 as allowed by the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement by and between the County Commission of Taney County, the Missouri Board of Governors of Missouri State University on behalf of the Southwest Missouri Council of Governments and the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency;

WHEREAS, if a partial payment-in-kind match is offered in lieu of cash match, the County agrees to make available to SMCOG, copies of all time cards/sheets, vouchers, and other paperwork documenting hourly rates and the costs of labor expended on the project. SMCOG agrees to track all provided documentation and prepare required reports to SEMA.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Taney County Commission and the Southwest Missouri Council of Governments do hereby agree to the terms set forth in this memorandum of agreement.
