TANEY COUNTY SEWER SALES TAX RENEWAL ORDER

Brad Allbritton, Sewer District Administrator, and Jonas Arjes, Executive Director Taney County Partnership, were present.

Commissioner Wyatt moved to approve the order as it was presented for the Taney County Sewer Sales Tax Renewal to be put on the ballot on August 3, 2021. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Scofield (aye), Williams (aye), and Wyatt (aye).

ORDER OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF TANEY COUNTY, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, § 67.547, RSMo. authorizes the governing body of a county to impose a countywide sales tax on all sales which are subject to taxation under the provisions of §§ 144.10 to 144.525, RSMo.; and

WHEREAS, § 67.547, RSMo. provides that the tax authorized by that section shall be in addition to any and all other sales taxes allowed by law, except that no ordinance or order imposing a sales tax shall be effective unless the governing body of the county submits to the voters of the county, at a county or state general, primary or special election, a proposal to authorize the governing body of the county to impose a tax; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 1993, pursuant to § 67.547, RSMo., the voters of Taney County approved imposing a countywide sales tax for the purpose of funding capital improvements for sewer purposes at the rate of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%), for a period of 10 years from the date on which the tax was imposed; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2000, pursuant to §67.547, RSMo., the voters approved continuing to impose the countywide sales tax, in part for sewer purposes at the rate of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%), for a period of 20 years from the date on which the tax was reimposed, and which is set to expire on or before October, 2023;

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Taney County, Missouri, has determined and does now find and determine that a ballot question shall be submitted to the voters of the county to authorize continuing to impose the existing countywide sales tax of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) pursuant to $\S 67.547$, RSMo., for an additional period of twenty-five (25) years on all sales which are subject to taxation under \$\$144.010 to 144.525, RSMo. for sewer purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission desires to submit a proposal in the form of a ballot question to the voters of Taney County, Missouri, at the election to be held on August 3, 2021, authorizing the County Commission of Taney County, Missouri, to continue to impose a countywide sales tax of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) pursuant to § 67.547, RSMo. for an additional period of twenty-five (25) years for sewer purposes; and

WHEREAS, in the event a majority of the votes cast on the proposal by the qualified voters voting thereon are in favor of the proposal, then a countywide sales tax of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) for sewer purposes shall be imposed and in effect for an additional period of twenty-five (25) years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF TANEY COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

 <u>Confirmation</u>. The County Commission incorporates by reference the recitals, statements and reasons set forth above and confirms that they are true and correct.

2. <u>Order of County Commission</u>. The Taney County Commission hereby orders submission of the following ballot question to the voters of Taney County, Missouri, at the election to be held August 3, 2021, to authorize the County Commission to continue to impose

WITNESSETH:
