#### for Security Camera Services

THIS AGREEMENT dated the  $18^{th}$  day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ 2021, is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and NetWatch Fire Protection, LLC, a Missouri limited liability company (hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

<u>1. Contract Documents.</u> The contract documents to this Agreement are for the acquisition of services on the Taney County Judicial Facility camera system ("Service") and shall include the Contractor's quote # 202112-15 and any applicable addenda which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

2. Contract Price. Service provided under this Agreement shall not exceed the pricing as quoted within quote # 202112-15, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference

<u>3. Contract Duration.</u> This term of this Agreement shall be one (1) year commencing on the date it is fully executed, subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This Agreement may be automatically renewed for an additional one (1) year term. Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing notice, in writing, thirty (30) days prior to the end of the current term.

<u>4. Billing and Payment.</u> All billing shall be invoiced with specific department information and include quote reference # 202112-15 for tracking. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for in this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

<u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

<u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other quote or quote specification or contractual Agreement.
