Agreement For SkyMark 1,000 Gallon Avgas Aircraft Refueler

THIS AGREEMENT dated the <u>lot</u> day of <u>2022</u> is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and SkyMark Refuelers, LLC, a Kansas limited liability company (hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

<u>1. Contract Documents.</u> The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of a SkyMark 1,000 Gallon Avgas Aircraft Refueler ("Equipment") shall include the quote dated April 15, 2022 and cooperative purchasing GSA Contract #47QMCA20D0010 and any applicable addenda which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference ("Contract Documents"). Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

2. Contract Price. Equipment provided under this Agreement shall not exceed the cost of \$126,850 as quoted in Exhibit A, plus freight with a cost not to exceed \$2,500. The County agrees to this purchase and Contractor agrees to supply the County the items, services, and construction as ordered by County.

<u>3. Contract Duration.</u> This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties as subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This agreement may only be extended by the order of the county subject to herein.

<u>4. Billing and Payment.</u> All billing shall be invoiced with specific department information and include reference GSA Contract #47QMCA20D0010 for tracking. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for in this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

5. Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

<u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.

THIS AGREEMENT dated the <u>llath</u> day of <u>May</u> 202_ ("Effective Date") is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and Scurlock Industries of Springfield, Inc. of Springfield, Missouri 65803 (hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents. The Contract Documents to this Agreement for the purchase of precast concrete box culvert items ("Product") for Taney County Road & Bridge repair and maintenance shall include the Purchase Order, Greene County Missouri Contract #20-1294 as amended, and price list, copies of which are attached to this Agreement as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference. Product or Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

<u>2. <u>3. Contract Duration.</u> This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and terminate on September 7, 2022, unless extended or renewed by the parties, or by extension or renewal of Greene County Contract #20-1234, at the option of County. This Agreement may coincide with any/all extensions, and/or renewals, entered into by Greene County with Contractor – subject to pricing, and delivery clauses as agreed to, and offered by the Contractor at that time which is also consistent with Taney County Road & Bridge needs.

4. Billing and Payment. All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.
