DISPATCH AGREEMENT WITH CITY OF HOLLISTER #22-073S

Brad Daniels, Sheriff, and Erin Stottle, 911 Dispatch Supervisor, were present. Presiding Commissioner Scofield referenced a letter from their attorney.

Commissioner Williams approved the Intergovernmental Agreement for 911 Dispatch Services and Personnel by and between Taney County and the City of Hollister beginning on July 7, 2022. Commissioner Wyatt seconded the motion with discussion. The motion passed by vote: Scofield (aye), Williams (aye), and Wyatt (aye).

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR 911 DISPATCH SERVICES AND PERSONNEL

This Agreement, dated $\underline{5^{H}}$ day of July, 2022 is made by and between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, ("County") and City of Hollister, a municipality of the State of Missouri ("City").

WHEREAS, the City and County are authorized to enter into agreements for common services pursuant to § 70.220; and

WHEREAS, the City and County acknowledge and recognize the need for appropriate personnel and staffing levels for the efficient dispatching of emergency 911 calls and the County is well positioned to provide such dispatching services, and the parties desire to cooperate with one another in order to provide effective and efficient 911 dispatching services for the citizens of the City and County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and County each for and in consideration of the promises herein made by the other, hereby agree as follows:

1. <u>911 Dispatching Services and Personnel:</u> Pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, and in exchange for the consideration provided by the City as set forth in paragraph 3, below, the County agrees to provide 911 Dispatching Services to the City and to employ, in addition to its existing 911 dispatching personnel, two (2) additional 911 communications employees (the "Communications Employees") as well as such equipment, except for the equipment and maintenance provided for in paragraph 3, and licenses necessary in order for the Communications Employees to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position relating to the dispatching of emergency 911 calls and related duties, for the benefit of the City and its residents, and the County. The County shall be the sole employer of the Communications Employees, and the Communications Employees shall be subject to the employee compensation, benefits, policies and procedures of the County. The County shall select Communications Employees according to County policy and shall have the sole discretion regarding the hiring, firing, discipline and other employment matters relating to the Communications Employee.

2. <u>Expenses:</u> The County shall have the sole responsibility for the compensation, benefits, insurance, training and other expenses relating to the Communications Employees, which is the subject of this Agreement.

3. <u>Compensation</u>: In exchange for the services and personnel described in paragraph 1, above, the City shall pay the County One Hundred Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$105,000) per year and provide radio equipment, including the cost of maintenance, in consideration for the Communications Employees and services provided. The payment amount shall be paid in a single payment within thirty (30) days of execution of this Agreement by the parties. Subsequent payments shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the beginning of a Renewal Term.

4. <u>Term:</u> The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be July 7, 2022, and shall have an initial term of one (1) year ending on July 6, 2023 (the "Initial Term"). This Agreement shall
