Taney County Emergency Procurement Policy (PER RSMo. # 50.780.2): Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Policy the Taney County Commission may waive the requirement of competitive bids or proposals for supplies when the County Commission has determined that there exists a threat to life, property, public health, or public safety or when immediate expenditure is necessary for repairs to County property in order to protect against further loss of, or damage to, County property, to prevent or minimize serious disruption in County services or to ensure the integrity of County records. Emergency procurements shall be made with as much competition as is practicable under the circumstances. After an emergency procurement shall be noted in the minutes of the next regularly scheduled meeting. A written determination of the basis for the emergency and for the selection of the particular contractor shall be included in the contract file. As soon as practicable, a record of each emergency procurement shall be made including the contract. The County Purchasing Agent will assign a specific Emergency Event Procurement number ("EEP") for each event to cover all emergency purchases made within the necessary recovery timeframe as set by the Taney County Commission.

SUBJECT: ZONING DISTRICT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, Taney County, Missouri desires to coordinate physical development in accordance with its present and future needs; so as to conserve the natural resources of the County, to insure efficient expenditure of public funds and to promote the health, safety, convenience, prosperity and general welfare of its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has held public hearings in order to obtain public input concerning an amendment to the Taney County, Missouri Zoning District map, in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 64 and Section 64.863, RSMo.; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2022, the Taney County Planning Commission has recommended the amendment to the Zoning District map grid number L15, Oliver Township, from A-1 Agricultural District to NR-3 Multi-Family Nightly Rental District, requested by MRG Group LLC, Parcel Number 18-7.0-26-001-003-001.003, located off State Hwy. 265, Hollister, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, on November 28, 2022, the Taney County Commission issued Order Number 11-28-2022-03, relating to a Zoning District Amendment for Parcel Number 18-7.0-26-001-003-001.003, located at State Hwy. 265, Map Grid # L15, Oliver Township, Zoning District NR-3 (the "Order"), attached as <u>Exhibit A</u>; and

WHEREAS, on November 28, 2022, the Taney County Commission voted to "approve Order #11-28-2022-03 with the amendments in the order stating that it is NR1 not a NR3 also contingent to 12 total units single family structures and also with the contingency to limit it two stories based on the definition in the code book" the minutes of which are attached as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the Taney County Commission has found and determined that it is necessary to amend the Order consistent with the motion of the Commission of November 28, 2022 approving the Order as set forth herein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2023, at a duly called meeting of the Taney County Commission, the County Commission orders amendment of the Order to read as follows:

"NOW, THEREFORE, on this 28th day of November 2022, at a duly called meeting of the Taney County Commission, having received the recommendation of the Planning Commission and, after public notice, and in open session, upon motion made to approve and seconded, the Taney County Commission voted 3 in favor and 0 opposed to amend the Taney County, Missouri Zoning District map L15, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 64.845 through 64.880 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Taney County, Missouri Zoning District to be amended as follows and pursuant to the information below:

Further, contingent to 12 total units single family structures and also with the contingency to limit to two stories based on the definition in the code book.

WHEREAS, the parties agree that Company and County have an independent contractor relationship and neither party is an employee or agent of the other;

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:
