If you live in the County there is one issue on the ballot, "Shall Taney County, Missouri impose a County wide sales tax of 3% on all tangible personal property retail sales for adult use Marijuana sold in Taney County?" for the August 8th election. This will be the only issue if you're in the County that you will see on the ballot. It is a 3% sales tax for retail sales of adult use Marijuana. It is a sales tax, not a personal property tax, if you don't purchase you don't pay.

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ADDENDUM TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL DISPATCH AGREEMENT

THIS ADDENDUM ("Addendum") made this _____ day of July, 2023, by and between the County Commission of Taney County, Missouri ("County Commission"), the Taney County Sheriff ("Sheriff")(collectively "County"), and Western Taney County Fire District ("Fire District").

WHEREAS, County and Fire District entered into an Intergovernmental Dispatch Agreement dated August 1, 2021 ("Agreement"), attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, County and Fire District desire to amend the Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The parties agree to amend paragraph 4 of the Agreement to read as follows:

"4. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be August 1, 2023 and shall end on July 31, 2024. The Agreement shall automatically renew for additional one (1) year terms (each a "Renewal Term") unless either party notifies the other party in writing at least sixty (60) days prior to the termination of the Agreement at the end of any Term."

2. This Addendum is subject to the Agreement and to each and every term, covenant, condition and agreement set forth therein. County and City continue to be bound by the terms of the Agreement and remain primarily liable under the terms of the Agreement. The Agreement is modified only to the extent provided in paragraph 1, above.
