- > Provide prompt & professional responses to inquiries of real estate appraisals / valuations (in-person / over the phone)
- > Defend appraisals in Board of Equalization, County, & Circuit Court hearings / trials
- > Train / support the Appraisal Assistant-Data Collector
- > Assess & calculate depreciation of improvements by inspecting exterior (whenever possible, interior structures also)
