Under the direct supervision of the Animal Control manager, the Kennel Technician is responsible for ensuring the proper care & safety of animals. This position may require weekend and holiday work. Effective communication with the manager, the public, & consistent attendance is essential for this role.

- Maintain routine schedule for proper care & safety:
 - > Feed & waters animals
 - Sanitize food & water dishes
 - > Ensure a sanitary work environment
 - Bathe animals
 - Clean kennels
 - Administer medications as needed
- > Handle phone calls & walk-ins
 - > Assist the public in locating missing animals
 - > Facilitate adoption of available animals
 - Provide accurate costs & services information
 - Process payments
 - > Issue receipts
 - > Respond to field calls as required
 - > Transport animals
 - On Call once a month or as needed by supervisor
 - ➤ Lift up to 50lbs.
