THIS AGREEMENT dated the 3rd day of September 2024 is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and NRoute Enterprises LLC of Ozark, Missouri (hereinafter "Vendor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual consideration and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of one (1) or more Sheriff's Department Vehicles ("Vehicles") shall include the State of Missouri contract #CC240753002 and any applicable addenda. All such documents shall constitute the "Contract Documents", which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specifications and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

2. Contract Price. The County agrees to purchase from the Vendor and the Vendor agrees to sell to the County the vehicles pursuant to the Contract Documents for the contract price of \$42,238.00 per vehicle, with a total current purchase price of \$126,714.00 for three (3) vehicles. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Vehicle availability, the County may consider all other options.

3. Contract Duration. This Agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties, subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This Agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing and delivery clauses as agreed to and offered by the Vendor's bid response.

4. Billing and Payment. All billing shall be invoiced with specific department information for tracking. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Vendor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

5. Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

6. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 3rd day of September 2024 is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and Fall River Holdings, LLC dba Worldwide Steel Buildings, Peculiar, Missouri of Ozark, Missouri (hereinafter "Vendor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual consideration and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase one (1) Evidence Storage Building ("Product") shall include the Contractor's bid response to County's Request For Bid #202407-561 and any applicable addenda which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 3rd day of September, 2024, by and between the Taney County Commission on behalf of Taney County, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "County" or "Lessor," and H & A Aircraft Services, LLC, an Arkansas limited liability company in good standing, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee".

WHEREAS, Taney County, Missouri is the owner of Taney County Airport (hereinafter referred to as "Airport"), located in the County of Taney, State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, County has space available for an aircraft maintenance operation, and said aircraft maintenance operation could be of use to customers of the airport; and

WHEREAS Lessee is desirous of securing and entering into an agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") to provide adequate facilities and services to meet the demands of the public, patrons, and other persons at the Airport for aircraft maintenance services;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained to be kept and performed and the consideration to be paid to County by Lessee, do agree as follows:

LEASED PREMISES, TERM, RENTAL

That in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained on the part of the Lessee to be observed and performed, the Lessor does hereby lease and demise unto the Lessee and the Lessee does hereby take, lease and hire from the Lessor the premises which consists of certain space at the Taney County Airport/M. Graham Clark Airfield, located at Point Lookout, Taney County, Missouri, said premises more particularly described as follows:

Hangar #1, excluding the portion of the hangar currently used to store two R-44 helicopters and associated equipment.

To have and to hold unto the Lessee, its successors and assigns, for the term of one (1) year commencing the 1st day of September, 2024, and ending on the 31st day of August, 2025. At the expiration of the term of this Agreement, the agreement may be extended or a new agreement entered into after negotiation, upon the approval, in writing, of both parties.

Lessee shall pay rent to Lessor in the amount of **ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$1,000)** per month. Said rent is due in advance on the first day of each month. The rent shall be paid at the office of the Airport Manager at the Taney County Airport or at such place designated by said Airport Manager.

LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 3rd day of September, 2024, by and between the Taney County Commission on behalf of Taney County, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "County," and **Chopper Charter Branson, LLC**, a Missouri corporation in good standing, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee".

WHEREAS, Taney County, Missouri is the owner of Taney County Airport (hereinafter referred to as "Airport"), located in the County of Taney, State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, County has space available for the operation of a helicopter tour and charter operation and said tour and charter operation is a benefit to the community, and

WHEREAS, Lessee is desirous of securing and entering into an agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") for space at the airport so that it can provide tour and charter services to the general public;

That in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained on the part of the Lessee to be observed and performed, the Lessor does hereby lease and demise unto the Lessee and the Lessee does hereby take, lease and hire from the Lessor the premises which consists of certain space at the Taney County Airport/M. Graham Clark Airfield, located at Point Lookout, Taney County, Missouri, said premises more particularly described as follows:

Building, including rooms and facilities within the building, located on the east end of Taney County Airport and just south of Taxiway B.

County reserves to itself use of a portion of the storage space located on the east side of said leased building, where there is currently stored airport runway and taxiway lighting regulators and other County equipment.

Parking space for additional aircraft associated with Lessee's business operations for short periods of time shall not be denied, and said parking is permitted only in the space immediately north of the leased building.

Lessor shall also provide parking spaces for Lessee's employee's automobiles in currently existing parking lot spaces in parking lot adjacent to the premise.

To have and to hold unto the Lessee, its successors and assigns, for the term of three (3) years commencing the 1st day of September, 2024, and ending on the 31st day of August,

ADDENDUM TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CITY OF HOLLISTER – TURKEY CREEK RIVER GAUGE FILE NO. 24-112CM

Presiding Commissioner Plummer referenced a letter from their attorney.

Commissioner Williams moved to approve the Addendum to Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement by and between the City of Hollister and Taney County. Commissioner Wyatt seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Plummer (aye), Williams (aye) and Wyatt (aye).

ADDENDUM TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into this 3rd day of August, 2024 (“Effective Date”), by and between Taney County, Missouri (“County”), a county of the first classification and the City of Hollister, Missouri (“City”), a city of the fourth classification.

WHEREAS, section 70.220, RSMo. permits political subdivisions to contract and cooperate with one another for the planning, development, construction, acquisition or operation of any public improvement or facility or common service; and

WHEREAS, the County anticipates entering into a Joint Funding Agreement for Water Resource Investigations (“Joint Funding Agreement”) with the U.S. Department of the Interior, U.S. Geological Survey (“USGS”) for the operation and maintenance of a stream gage on Turkey Creek near Hollister, Missouri (the “Program”); and

WHEREAS, the cost of the Program is \$16,300 for the period of October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City desire to share in the cost of the Program for the benefit of the citizens of the City and County; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement dated August 30, 2023 (“Agreement”), outlining the terms of their agreement with respect to sharing in the cost of the Program; and

WHEREAS, the County and City desire to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional year;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Reimbursement. The City agrees to reimburse the County for one-half (1/2) of the cost of the Program in the amount Eight Thousand, One Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$8,150) to cover the costs of the necessary field and analytical work for the operation and maintenance of a stream gage on Turkey Creek near Hollister, Missouri, to be paid by the City to the County in equal amounts on a quarterly basis. The County may invoice the City, or may provide the billing statement from USGS to the City which shall constitute notice of the obligation by the City to pay the County pursuant to this paragraph.

2. Term. The term of this Agreement shall be from October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025. In the event the County terminates the Joint Funding Agreement, the County or City may also terminate this Agreement by providing 60 days written notice to the other party.

3. Terms and Conditions. Except as specifically set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into as of the October 1, 2024, by the U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, Central Midwest Water Science Center, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, party of the first part, and the Taney County, Missouri party of the second part.

1. The parties hereto agree that subject to the availability of appropriations and in accordance with their respective authorities there shall be maintained in cooperation, the operation and maintenance of a streamgagage on Turkey Creek near Hollister, Missouri, herein called the program. The USGS legal authority is 43 USC 36C; 43 USC 50, and 43 USC 50b.

2. The following amounts shall be contributed to cover all of the cost of the necessary field and analytical work directly related to this program. 2(b) include In-Kind-Services in the amount of \$0.00

- (a) \$0 by the party of the first part during the period October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025
- (b) \$16,300 by the party of the second part during the period October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025
- (c) Contributions are provided by the party of the first part through other USGS regional or national programs, in the amount of: \$0

Description of the USGS regional/national program:

- (d) Additional or reduced amounts by each party during the above period or succeeding periods as may be determined by mutual agreement and set forth in an exchange of letters between the parties.
- (e) The performance period may be changed by mutual agreement and set forth in an exchange of letters between the parties.

3. The costs of this program may be paid by either party in conformity with the laws and regulations respectively governing each party.

4. The field and analytical work pertaining to this program shall be under the direction of or subject to periodic review by an authorized representative of the party of the first part.

5. The areas to be included in the program shall be determined by mutual agreement between the parties hereto or their authorized representatives. The methods employed in the field and office shall be those adopted by the party of the first part to insure the required standards of accuracy subject to modification by mutual agreement.

6. During the course of this program, all field and analytical work of either party pertaining to this program shall be open to the inspection of the other party, and if the work is not being carried on in a mutually satisfactory manner, either party may terminate this agreement upon 60 days written notice to the other party.

7. The original records resulting from this program will be deposited in the office of origin of those records. Upon request, copies of the original records will be provided to the office of the other party.

8. The maps, records or reports resulting from this program shall be made available to the public as promptly as possible. The maps, records or reports normally will be published by the party of the first part. However, the party of the second part reserves the right to publish the results of this program, and if already published by the party of the first part shall, upon request, be furnished by the party of the first part, at cost, impressions suitable for purposes of reproduction similar to that for which the original copy was prepared. The maps, records or reports published by either party shall contain a statement of the cooperative relations between the parties. The Parties acknowledge that scientific information and data developed as a result of the Scope of Work (SOW) are subject to applicable USGS review, approval, and release requirements, which are available on the USGS Fundamental Science Practices website (<https://www.usgs.gov/office-of-science-quality-and-integrity/fundamental-science-practices>).
