AGREEMENT FOR DAY CAB PULL TRUCK (1 OR MORE) FILE NO. 24-127RB

Devon Huff, Road and Bridge Administrator, was present. Presiding Commissioner Plummer referenced a letter from their attorney.

Commissioner Williams moved to approve the Agreement for Day Cap Pull Truck (1 or more) by and between Taney County and Ozark Kenworth Inc, d/b/a MHC Kenworth. Commissioner Wyatt seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Plummer (aye), Williams (aye), and Wyatt (aye).

Agreement For Day Cab Pull Truck (1 or more)

THIS AGREEMENT dated the <u>15 ¹/2</u> day of <u>Octo ber</u> 2024 is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri ("County") and Ozark Kenworth Inc. dba MHC Kenworth of Leawood, Kansas ("Contractor").

IN CONSIDERATION of the parties performance of the respective obligations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of a three (3) or more day cab pull trucks ("Equipment") shall include Quote dated October 1, 2024 and the cooperative purchasing contract documents of Sourecewell Contract 032824-KTC, all of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A ("Contract Documents"). Service or product data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

2. <u>Contract Price</u>. The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County the Equipment provided under this agreement. The purchase price shall not exceed \$183,854.54 per unit, excluding FET. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to delivery, or product availability, the County may consider all other options.

3. <u>Contract Duration</u>. This Agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties. This Agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing and delivery clauses agreed to and offered by the Contractor.

4. <u>Billing and Payment.</u> All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for in this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

5. <u>Binding Effect.</u> - This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this agreement remains in full force and effect.

6. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
