#### TANEY COUNTY CORRECTION OFFICER TRAINING AGREEMENT

THIS TRAINING AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_\_, by and between Taney County, Missouri ("County"), and \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, an employee of the Taney County Sheriff's Office, located in Forsyth, Missouri ("Employee");

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Employee is currently employed as a Correction Officer for Taney County ("County"); and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Academy at the Missouri Sheriff's Association Academy ("Police Academy") is scheduled to start mid-January 2025; and

WHEREAS, the County desires that Employee meet certain minimum training requirements in order to be qualified to perform the duties of Correction Officer for the County; and

WHEREAS, in return for pay and benefits while employed as a Correction Officer and while attending the Police Academy, Employee agrees to remain employed in good standing with the Taney County Sheriff's Office for at least two (2) years upon successful completion of Police Academy following the first day of employment with the County.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE COVENANTS AS SET FORTH HEREIN, IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Recitals.</u> The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. <u>At-Will Employment.\_This Agreement in no way changes the "at will" employment</u> relationship between Employee and County, where either party may terminate the employment relationship at any time and for any reason, with or without notice.
- 3. No Guarantee of Employment. This Agreement in no way guarantees employment or any right of employment for Employee. Nor does it have any effect on the authority of the Presiding Commissioner, the Sheriff, or their authorized representatives to invoke disciplinary action against Employee, up to and including termination of employment.
- 4. <u>Term.</u> The term of this Agreement shall be two (2) years, beginning \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_.

#### Public Administrator's Office Bond

THIS AGREEMENT dated the <u>16</u><sup>26</sup> day of <u>December</u> 2024 is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (hereinafter "County") and Golden Rule Insurance Agency, Inc. of Versailles, Missouri (hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual consideration and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

<u>1. Contract Documents.</u> The contract documents to this Agreement for the Public Administrator's Office Bond ("Bond") shall include the Contractor's bid response to County's Request For Bid #202410-568 and any applicable addenda. All such documents shall constitute the "Contract Documents", which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specifications and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office bid file for this bid if not attached. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.

<u>2. Contract Price.</u> The Bond provided under this Agreement shall not exceed the costs as quoted in Contractor's bid response, as fully attached. The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to supply the County the Bond per the Contractor's bid response, and for the prices set forth in the Contractor's bid response, and as ordered by County, however, in no event shall the total price paid by County exceed the total bid price of \$14,400.00. The Bond shall comply with the requirements of § 473.733, RSMo. and shall provide bond coverage of \$2.4 million dollars. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Equipment availability, the County may consider all other options.

<u>3. Contract Duration.</u> This agreement shall commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2025 and extend for forty-eight (48) months, subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This Agreement may be renewed thereafter on a month to month basis for up to six months in the event County is unable to re-bid and award a new contract prior to the expiration, subject to the pricing and delivery clauses as agreed to and offered by the Contractor's bid response.

<u>4. Billing and Payment.</u> All billing shall be invoiced with specific department information for tracking. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for in this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

<u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

#### CITY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT: LIFT STATION #10 & #34 UPGRADE PROJECT (CONSTRUCTION PHASE)

- 1. The County and City entered into an Inter-Governmental Funding Agreement on April 16, 2024, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, for the purpose of completing the items as outlined in the above referenced funding agreement by December 31, 2024.
- 2. The project start date was delayed due to unforeseen circumstances of the contractor taking longer than expected to obtain the equipment necessary for the upgrades from the vendor. With that, the City is requesting a new funding agreement termination date of May 31, 2025 to allow additional time for the project to be completed and processing of the reimbursement request.
- 3. The County agrees to extend the funding agreement termination date to May 31, 2025.
