On behalf of the Taney County Commission, we are writing to express our strong support for the Southwest Missouri Council of Governments' (SMCOG) application to the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) program. This funding will enable the much-needed update of Taney County's Master Plan, which has not been comprehensively updated since 1998.

 - Action 2.4: Adopt updated international codes and land use development policies.

Updating the Master Plan will provide a comprehensive approach to meeting these goals and actions. By incorporating modern land use practices, enhanced floodplain management strategies, and robust development codes, the updated plan will guide sustainable growth while mitigating risks to life, property, and infrastructure. This effort will also enable the County to leverage additional resources and partnerships, ensuring that our communities are more resilient to the impacts of natural disasters.

The Master Plan update is critical not only for mitigating flooding impacts but also for addressing broader concerns tied to disaster resilience, including stormwater management, infrastructure protection, and economic stability. It will provide a roadmap for informed decision-making, protecting vulnerable areas and promoting sustainable development practices throughout the County.

We urge the Missouri Department of Economic Development to support SMCOG's application for CDBG-MIT funding. The updated Master Plan will be a vital tool in ensuring the safety and prosperity of Taney County's residents and businesses.
