JOB SUMMARY:

Corrections Officers shall be responsible for providing security, care, custody & control of inmates at the Taney County Jail. The Corrections Officer may be assigned to different posts, areas and/or shifts, depending on operational needs. Open communication with supervisor is key for this position

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Process inmates into & release inmates from jail
- Move inmates between cells
- Inspect inmate cells for unauthorized goods
- Maintain various jail records & logs & write daily reports
- Detect & recognize potential hazards in the facility for the safety of the inmates
- Interact & communicate effectively with inmates & staff to maintain order in the facility
- Use sound judgment, self-control & common sense to quickly de-escalate hostile situations when they arise

QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Working knowledge of computer hardware, software & accessories
