Agreement for 2025 Ford F-150 Police Responder (1 or more)

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of two (2) 2025 Ford F-150 Police Responder for the Taney County Sheriff's Office ("Equipment") shall include the Contractor's bid response to County's Request For Bid #202502-572 and any applicable addenda. All such documents shall constitute the "Contract Documents" which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. Service or product data, specifications and literature submitted with bid response may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.
- 2. Contract Price. County agrees to purchase and Contractor agrees to sell the Equipment described in this Agreement, at a purchase price not to exceed \$47,051.00 (delivered) per vehicle. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Equipment availability, the County may consider all other options for cooperative purchasing.
- 3. Contract <u>Duration</u>. This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties. This agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing, and delivery clauses as agreed to, and offered by the Contractor's bid response.
- 4. Payment. County agrees to pay the Contract Price at the time of pickup of the Equipment from Contractor by check. The Contract Price may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents.
- <u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.
- <u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
- 7. Termination. This Agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty days advance written notice for any of the following reasons or under any of the following circumstances:
 - a. Due to material breach of any term or condition of this Agreement, or
 b. If in the opinion of the Taney County Commission Services are delayed or
 are not provided in conformity with specifications or variances authorized by County, or

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
