In consideration of being permitted to offer, conduct, organize or sponsor the Spring Fling on April 26, 2025 and to conduct certain physical fitness activities in connection with a Strongman Competition ("Activities") on real property owned by Taney County, Missouri ("County") located 132 David Street, Forsyth, Missouri, or 266 Main Street, Forsyth, Missouri ("Premises"), which are conducted, organized or sponsored by Forsyth Chamber of Commerce, and its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, or agents, and being permitted to enter onto or participate for any purpose upon the property for which Spring Fling activities or events are offered, conducted, organized or sponsored by Forsyth Chamber of Commerce ("Chamber"), Chamber agrees as follows:

1. Chamber acknowledges, agrees, and represents that it has or will immediately upon entering the Premises and continuously thereafter, inspect the Premises, and further agrees and warrants that if at any time Chamber and its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents or participants are in or about the Premises and feel or observe anything to be unsafe, Chamber will immediately advise County of such and if necessary, will immediately require all officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents, participants, observers, attendees, and all others to immediately leave the Premises.

2. Chamber and its officers, managers, employees, volunteers, agents and participants release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the County, or its officers, officials, employees, volunteers, or agents (collectively, the "Released Parties"), for any and all liability in connection with Spring Fling and the related Activities and Events, including any and all loss or damages, and any claim or demands on account of injury to person or property or resulting in death or injury in connection with Spring Fling and the related Activities and events arising out of or related to the Premises, and any and all Spring Fling Activities and events, whether caused by the negligence of the County, or not.

3. Chamber agrees to indemnify and save and hold harmless the County, and its officers, officials, employees, volunteers, or agents from any loss, liability, damage or cost that may be incurred arising out of or related to the Premises, and any Spring Fling activities or events, whether caused by the County, or not.

4. Chamber assumes full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death or property damage, including, but not limited to any person(s) on the Premises, arising out of or related to the Premises, and any Spring Fling Activities and events, whether caused by the negligence of the County, or not.

5. Chamber agrees that this Liability Waiver and Release, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the County, and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Missouri, and that if any portion is held invalid, it is agreed that the remaining part of the Agreement shall continue in full legal force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

<u>1. Contract Documents.</u> The contract documents to this Agreement to purchase one (1) Weiler Asphalt Paver and necessary equipment ("Equipment") shall include Sales Agreement and Proposal dated March 28, 2025, and the cooperative purchasing contract documents of Sourcewell Contract #060122-WLR, all of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A ("Contract Documents"). <u>3. Contract Duration.</u> This agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties. This agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing, and delivery clauses as agreed to, and offered by the Contractor's bid response.

<u>4. Billing and Payment.</u> All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.

<u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.

<u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, section 70.220, RSMo. authorizes any municipality or political subdivision to contract and cooperate with one another, and their elective or appointive officials for the planning, development, construction, acquisition or operation of public improvements or facilities and common services; and

WHEREAS, at a referendum election, the voters of Taney County, Missouri approved the establishment and operation of a county-wide 911 emergency telephone system and a levy to fund the system; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Branson, Missouri ("City"), have entered into a Mutual Cooperation Agreement for 911 Emergency Telephone System setting forth the terms and obligations of the County and City with respect to providing a 911 Emergency Telephone System and Public Service Answering Points in Taney County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the County, Sheriff, and City have cooperated to establish and maintain two Public Service Answering Points ("PSAP), with one being located in the Taney County Sheriff's Office, and the other being located at 110 West Maddux Street or 616 West Pacific Street in Branson; and

WHEREAS, the County and Sheriff desire to set forth a memorandum of understanding with respect to providing a 911 Emergency Telephone System and Public Service Answering Points in Taney County, Missouri in the Sheriff's Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. <u>Operation of PSAPs.</u> There shall be two PSAPs operated with one operated by the City and one operated by the County. The Sheriff shall maintain, operate, and supervise the respective PSAP 24-hours per day, 7-days per week, and shall provide a minimum of two (2) dispatchers (or such other position title is assigned by the respective party) ("Dispatcher") on duty at all times. Each PSAP shall be responsible for answering emergency telephone calls; operating PSAP equipment and voice recorders; and handling to completion all 911 emergency calls routed to and accepted by the respective PSAP. In the event of interruption or failure of PSAP service at a location, each PSAP shall provide full emergency back-up service to the other. Sheriff shall provide suitable and appropriate office space and employees for the respective PSAPs, as follows:

a. <u>By Sheriff.</u> Sheriff agrees to and shall maintain, operate, and supervise one (1) PSAP location, to be located at the Taney County Sheriff's Department. Sheriff will recruit, select, hire, train, compensate, discipline and terminate all
