Although there were two companies that stood out in cost and services provided, PSD Citywide and iWorQ Systems, it was clear that there are a couple clear advantages that PSD Citywide has over iWorQ, connectivity and mobile application. we recommend the Commission award to PSD Citywide Inc., Irving, Texas. and ask the Commission for a motion vote as such.

After a discussion ensued, the Taney County Commission accepted the recommendation from Road & Bridge, making a motion to award PSD Citywide Inc., Irving, Texas, and it passed by vote.

## Asset Management Software

Both PSD Citywide and iWorQ are cloud based Asset and Fleet Management Software that are very similar in set up and usability. Though there are small differences between the programs, both are customizable to the specific asset tracking needs of the county and appear to be user friendly without a large learning curve. However, having seen a demo of both programs, we feel that PDS Citywide has the has the advantage as there are a couple aspects that definitely sets PSD Citywide apart:

One – The program can still be used even when in an area that does not allow for internet access (Any changes made will update when connectivity is re-established)

Two — They have a simplified version of the program as a mobile app that can be used with a smart phone. With iWorQ the program view is the same whether on a desktop screen or on a phone size screen. (although there are apparently some configurations you can make based on the user they may enable it to have less information when viewed on the phone)

Correctly tracking the assets cared for by the Road and Bridge Department is critical to the continued growth of this county and worthy of choosing the correct tool for doing so. Our software is the only purchase we make that will literally touch every single asset that we own and is critical to the running of the department. While we are aware that they are not the lowest bid, coming in at second place, we feel that PSD Citywide is the best choice for this. The added ability of the Supervisors to use the PSD Citywide App to track and close out their assigned Work Orders on their phone in a simple manner, regardless of location in the county and without the necessity of purchasing new devices and the subscription fees associated with them, is absolutely worth the additional \$7500 in annual costs in comparison with iWorqs. And though the implementation fee of \$54,900 is higher than that of many of the other companies that bid, their annual cost of \$35,000 easily offsets that as it is the second lowest of any bid, other than iWorQs, coming in at \$19,049 less than the next lowest annual cost.

After examining the options and considering what would work best both now and as we look towards the future, we respectfully request that PSD Citywide be awarded the bid.
