Memorandum of Understanding CoxHealth Rural Forensic Response Initiative

WHEREAS, Lester E. Cox Medical Centers, DBA CoxHealth ("CoxHealth"), Child Advocacy Center, Missouri State Highway Patrol, Taney County Sherrif's Office, Branson Police Department, and Taney County Prosecutor's Office have come together to collaborate and to submit an application for funding through the OVW Fiscal Year 2025 Rural Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, and Stalking Program; and

WHEREAS, the partners listed herein have agreed to enter into a collaborative agreement in which CoxHealth will be the lead agency and named applicant and the other agencies will be implementing partners in this application; and

WHEREAS, the partners herein desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding setting forth the services to be provided by the collaborative; and

WHEREAS, the application prepared by CoxHealth with input from the collaborative through its partners is to be submitted to the Office of Violence Against Women on or before July 10, 2025;

I. Partner Agencies

- CoxHealth (Lead Applicant) is a nonprofit healthcare system founded in 1906, operating 6 hospitals and over 80 clinics. CoxHealth currently offers full forensic services at its Springfield hospital and seeks to expand these services to CoxHealth Branson through this proposal.
- Child Advocacy Center provides a child-friendly, trauma-informed setting for forensic interviews and medical exams for children who may have experienced abuse.
- Missouri Department of Social Services Children's Division is the state agency responsible for investigating and responding to child abuse and neglect.
- Missouri Department of Social Services State Technical Assistance Team (STAT)
 provides investigative and technical support in cases involving crimes against children, and
 facilitates training and inter-agency coordination.
- Missouri State Highway Patrol enforces state laws and works to maintain public safety across rural and urban regions in Missouri.
- Taney County Sheriff's Office is responsible for law enforcement in Taney County, including response to domestic violence, sexual assault, and child abuse.
- Branson Police Department provides public safety and criminal investigation services for the City of Branson.
- Taney County Prosecutor's Office prosecutes criminal cases in the jurisdiction and coordinates closely with MDT members on legal proceedings related to violence and abuse.

Southwestern Missouri Cyber Crimes Task Force

Memorandum of Understanding

Parties

The Southwestern Missouri Cyber Crimes Task Force (SMCCTF) is a partially grant funded, multi-agency endeavor. Grant funding comes from the Missouri Department of Public Safety and Missouri Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (MO ICAC).

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between the following agencies:

Taney County Sheriff's Office and the Southwestern MO Cyber Crimes Task Force

Nothing in this MOU should be construed as limiting or impeding the basic spirit of cooperation that exists between the participating agencies.

Mission

The mission of the SMCCTF is to investigate, apprehend, and prosecute internet sexual predators who exploit children through the use of the internet and technology, consistent with ICAC standards and procedures. The SMCCTF produces high-quality investigations leading to successful prosecutions of internet sexual predators. The SMCCTF conducts forensic examinations of evidence seized through the course of an investigation. The SMCCTF participates in community education efforts regarding the prevention of internet crimes against children (ICAC). As funding is available, the SMCCTF provides funding for personnel, overtime, equipment, training and other approved investigative costs.

Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to delineate the responsibilities of the SMCCTF, maximize inter-agency cooperation, and formalize relationships between member-agencies. The Task Force investigates suspects who utilize the Internet to seek children as sexual partners and/or who traffic in child pornography. Specific ICAC crimes include, but are not limited to: Internet sexual exploitation of a minor and luring a minor for sexual exploitation as described in applicable Federal and State Law. This MOU does not prohibit the investigation of other crimes against children.

Duration and Termination

This MOU will remain in effect for the period of time that the SMCCTF is in existence. Renewal of the agreement will be automatic unless either party terminates the agreement. Task Force member agencies may voluntarily withdraw participation at any time by providing written notice. Membership may be terminated by written notice of violation of this MOU and/or ICAC operational and investigative standards.
