ADDENDUM TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR 911 DISPATCH SERVICES AND PERSONNEL

THIS ADDENDUM ("Addendum") made this 13th day of August, 2025, by and between Taney County, Missouri ("County") and City of Hollister ("City").

WHEREAS, County and City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for 911 Dispatch Services and Personnel dated July 5, 2022, and an Addendum on July 24, 2023 ("Agreement"), attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, County, and City desire to amend the Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

- The parties agree to amend paragraph 4 of the Agreement to read as follows:
- Term: The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be July 7, 2025, and shall end on July 6, 2026. The Agreement shall automatically renew for additional one (1) year terms (each a "Renewal Term") unless either party notifies the other party in writing at least sixty (60) days prior to the termination of the Agreement at the end of any Term, provided that the County may submit proposed changes to the compensation amount pursuant to paragraph 3 due to increases labor costs prior to the beginning of a Renewal Term. In the event the County submits a proposed change to the compensation amount within sixty (60) days of the end of a Term, the City may terminate the Agreement prior to the effective date of the Renewal Term."
- This Addendum is subject to the Agreement and to each and every term, covenant, condition and agreement set forth therein. County and City continue to be bound by the terms of the Agreement and remain primarily liable under the terms of the Agreement. The Agreement is modified only to the extent provided in paragraph 1, above.

WHEREAS, Taney County, Missouri is the owner of Taney County Airport (hereinafter referred to as "Airport"), located in the County of Taney, State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, County has space available for an aircraft maintenance operation, and said aircraft maintenance operation could be of use to customers of the airport; and

WHEREAS Lessee is desirous of securing and entering into an agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") to provide adequate facilities and services to meet the demands of the public, patrons, and other persons at the Airport for aircraft maintenance services;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained to be kept and performed and the consideration to be paid to County by Lessee, do agree as follows:

LEASED PREMISES, TERM, RENTAL

That in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained on the part of the Lessee to be observed and performed, the Lessor does hereby lease and demise unto the Lessee and the Lessee does hereby take, lease and hire from the Lessor the premises which consists of certain space at the Taney County Airport/M. Graham Clark Airfield, located at Point Lookout, Taney County, Missouri, said premises more particularly described as follows:

Hangar #1, excluding the portion of the hangar currently used to store two R-44 helicopters and associated equipment.

To have and to hold unto the Lessee, its successors and assigns, for the term of one (1) year commencing the 1st day of September, 2025, and ending on the 31st day of August, 2026. NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of Motorola Radio Communications Equipment for the Sheriff's Office ("Equipment") shall include Quote No. 3121258, cooperative purchase through Sourcewell Contract No. 041021-MOT and any applicable addenda which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A ("Contract Documents"). Product or Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. This Agreement shall be subject to the requirements, terms, and conditions set forth in the Contract Documents. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.
- 2. Contract Price. The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to sell to the County pursuant to the Contract Documents for the total contract price of \$372,280.32. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Equipment availability, the County may consider all other options.
- 3. Contract Duration. This Agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties, subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This Agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing and delivery clauses agreed to and offered by the Contractor's bid response.
- 4. Billing and Payment. All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.
- <u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.
- <u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
