THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY, hereinafter referred to as the Secretary, under authority of Title 10, United States Code, Section 2668, hereby grants to County of Taney, P.O. Agreement For Paver and Related Equipment

THIS AGREEMENT dated the 30 day of September 2025 is made between Taney County, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, (-hereinafter "County") and John Fabick Tractor Company, St. Louis, Missouri (hereinafter "Contractor").

NOW, THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual considerations and obligations of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contract Documents. The contract documents to this Agreement for the purchase of a Paver and Related Equipment for the Road & Bridge Department ("Equipment") shall include Quote No(s). 231351-01, 232536-01 and 227401-01, cooperative purchase through Sourcewell Contract No. 011723-CAT and any applicable addenda which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A ("Contract Documents"). Product or Services data, specifications and literature submitted may be permanently maintained in the County Purchasing Office. This Agreement shall be subject to the requirements, terms, and conditions set forth in the Contract Documents. In the event of a conflict between any of the foregoing Contract Documents, and this Agreement, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall prevail and control.
- 2. Contract Price. The County agrees to purchase from the Contractor and the Contractor agrees to sell to the County pursuant to the Contract Documents for the total contract price of \$632,250.47. If certain unusual circumstances occur specific to Equipment availability, the County may consider all other options.
- 3. Contract Duration. This Agreement shall commence on the date it is fully executed and terminate upon expiration of all applicable warranties, subject to the provisions for termination specified below. This Agreement may only be extended by the order of the County subject to the pricing and delivery clauses agreed to and offered by the Contractor's bid response.
- 4. Billing and Payment. All billing must be invoiced with specific department information. Billings and invoices may only include the prices provided for via this Agreement. No additional fees or extra services not included, or taxes, shall be included as additional charges in excess of the charges in this Agreement or the Contract Documents. The County agrees to pay all correct statements within thirty days of receipt; Contractor agrees to honor any cash or prompt payment discounts, if any are available, when County makes payment as provided therein. In the event of a billing dispute, the County reserves the right to withhold payment on the disputed amount.
- <u>5. Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors and assigns for so long as this Agreement remains in full force and effect.
- <u>6. Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior negotiations, written or verbal, and any other bid or bid specification or contractual Agreement. This Agreement may only be amended by a signed writing executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
